1. **Call to Order:** 1905
2. **Pledge of Allegiance:** Led by Tony Mize
3. **Roll Call and Introductions:** All in attendance, we have a Quorum: Becky Luther, Denis Kidd, Barney Barnett, Raina Boal, Vince Yu, Melanie Zimmermann.
4. **Approval of Minutes:** Feb minutes not available. March minutes reviewed and approved. Moved to the next meeting.
5. **Old Business:**
 - Highgrove Day Report by Becky Luther and Vince Yu. Jordan Bullins will possibly be a country singer who will perform at Highgrove Day. Will pay for airfare from Knoxville and lodging in Riverside plus \$500.00. Highgrove Blossom Apt owner, Tony Mizes will donate \$500 towards the Country singer. Pancake breakfast is on for Highgrove Day. Permits have been approved. Phoenix Rising Band will play. Pony League will not be doing snack bar anymore. New Flyers were made up and brought but we need more local vendors.
 - Graffiti discussed: area of concern-bakery shop on Iowa Avenue. Tennant painted the building and it was hit again. He repainted and now the third time in a couple months hit again by spray-paint. Wanted to know what we could do as a community. We need volunteers for a graffiti committee.
6. **New Business:**
 - General Plan Update coming up again. We need an updated General Plan. Street name change and concrete curbs in SMR can be taken off General Plan because they are no longer an issue but sewers still needed. Asked about a program to make the former UP railroad track a trail since the track has been removed. Highgrove has asked for a General Plan update since June 1999 as evidenced by Highgrove Happenings article titled *Where is the "Highgrove" in*

the Highgrove General Plan? Need to add Highgrove Park to the Outdoor space website.

- CSA 126E parcel fee update: Barney met with the assessor's office and asked what is being paid to the assessor's office since 2009. Last October Barney showed Tavaglione our area and ask for an op-ed from him. Barney encouraged everyone to read the next article of Highgrove Happenings.

7. Agency Reports & Council Member Reports:

- Sheriff Report: Lt. David Kondrit \$25,000/yr for extra patrol. There is a plan in place for example the homeless which is a task force. \$138/hr for specialized Sheriff but \$80.57 is what we are paying from our CSA taxes. Sidewalks discussed and asked what is written for who and what we maintained in regards to graffiti. Mailbox theft brought up and encouraged to call with each incident. Federal case recently opened with the Post Master. If broken into call sheriff at 951-955-2600 or from cell phone 1-800-776-1099, get a report number then call the postmaster at 1-877-876-2355. Ask for a request for a call back. Call the deputy for update. IF NOT Contacted email Lt. Current stats reviewed. Next time we call and do not get a response contact Lt Kondrit. Illegal Board and Home facilities closed on Ruby Street. Board of Community licensing was able to close the houses. Appreciate Officer Bragg and Nuse as they were the officers who spearheaded this case. Becky asked is there was a noise ordinance.
- Code Enforcement: Not present but Barney stated Notice of Violation from a resident, but Code Enforcement went to the wrong resident.
- CHP Report: Not present
- Fire Dept. Report not present

 - Denis Kidd: Methodist Church free breakfast the last Saturday of the month 9-10 am.
